



## 6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade Virtual Classroom Agreement

At the beginning of the third nine weeks of school, the Smackover-Norphlet School District will offer a 100% online instructional option for 6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade students whose parents opt for them to not participate in on campus instruction. Digital content will be provided through APEX Learning based on student's current course schedule and availability of coursework in APEX.

### Eligibility for Virtual Classroom

Eligibility for to participate in Virtual Classroom during the third nine weeks of school is based on the following criteria:

- Be an existing student enrolled in Virtual Classroom on January 7, 2021. (No additional students will be accepted into the Virtual Classroom option after January 7, 2021.)
- Must have passed all classes for the first nine weeks and the second nine weeks.
- Must sign an updated Virtual Classroom Agreement.
- For parents and students of 6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> graders, the parent and student must physically attend an orientation to APEX.

### Student Responsibilities

- Be an existing Virtual Classroom student on January 7, 2021.
- Physically attend an APEX orientation meeting provided on campus.
- Submit assignments in a timely manner.
- Properly maintain the Chromebook provided by the district with appropriate care.
- Only use the Chromebook provided by the district for instructional purposes.
- Participate in all state required assessment on campus at the appropriately scheduled time.
- Maintain passing grades or better in all classes.
- Students with a failing grade at progress report or 9 weeks will be required to return to on-campus instruction.

## Parent Responsibilities

To be eligible for Virtual Classroom for the 3<sup>rd</sup> nine weeks, the student must be an existing Virtual Classroom student on January 7, 2021.

- Physically attend an APEX orientation meeting provided on campus.
- Designate an adult (at your home – not a school employee) who will serve as a learning coach (for 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students).
- Create a designated work space at your home for your child to complete assignments, etc.
- Monitor and ensure that students log in and complete assigned work.
- Provide reliable Internet connectivity and printer capability.
- Request assistance or support as needed through the assistant principal.
- Provide a valid phone number and email address for parent contact. Provide updates if either change.
- Students with a failing grade at progress report or 9 weeks will be required to return to on-campus instruction.
